Dunclug College is thrilled to offer an exciting opportunity for young football and sport fans to complete a BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Sport (equivalent to three A levels). This course will be delivered in partnership with Rangers Soccer Academy and will deliver first class teaching and coaching to the students.

Dunclug College has a proven track record of excellence in sport both on and off the field. Winners of the Mid-Antrim Shield and the Ulster High School's Plate competition, the students have excelled. Winning the League and Cup every Year from first to fifth Year, our young footballers made history and Dunclug College a name synonymous with football talent. With notable performances in NEBSSA athletics, Dunclug College is a school in which sport is a beating heart. Coached by our team of expert staff, hockey, netball, athletics, gymnastics, football, rugby, and badminton provide opportunity for all students to become involved in physical activity.

We promote sport through our profile of academic subjects, delivering Level 2 BTEC in Year 11 and 12 in preparation for Pearson BTEC Level 3 National Certificate in Sport (equivalent to 1 A Level) in Year 13 and Year 14, a course delivered successfully in our college for over ten years. It complements our wide and varied curriculum with an offer of 27 subjects at Post 16, enjoyed by a Sixth Form, with numbers in excess of 150 pupils each year.

This course brings a new dimension to an already comprehensive Post 16 provision. Joining with Rangers Soccer Academy in our first partnership of its kind, students will have opportunity to engage in a course with a focus on blending education and skills development. They will attend class each morning where the focus will be on education and attainment, whilst the afternoon sessions will devoted to skills development. While developing football skills on the pitch, students will also learn the fundamentals of coaching and refereeing and begin to develop an understanding of the power of video analysis when coaching. Students will benefit from A grade coaches from Rangers Football Club — a world class level of coaching — all within Dunclug College. This is a fabulous opportunity to put into practice the theory learned in the classroom and to make learning come alive.

Senior Soccer Academies Executive and Scout, Phil Cowan will be the lead contact in this partnership with Rangers Soccer Academy. Phil is well known to school, as he worked with us in support of former pupil, Ben Wylie, as he worked to secure his career in professional football, signing for Celtic Football Club in 2019.



Pearson BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Sport

The qualification consists of 10 mandatory units plus 4 optional units that provide for a combined total of 1080 guided learning hours (GLH).

You should note that there is no compensation for the mandatory units. These units must be successfully achieved

AIM: To prepare you for progression within education or into employment in the appropriate vocational sector and it is suitable whether you have decided to study in detail or work in a particular area of work

You may wish to gain the qualification in order to enter a specialist area of employment or to progress to a larger or different level 3/4 programme.

- Critical reasoning and analytical skills, including the capacity for **solving problems** and **thinking creatively**;


