PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT

Tracking Task: Pupils will be asked to bring a scripted performance to life in groups of 3/4, in relation to one of the three scenes they have looked at in class. The teacher will monitor the class as they rehearse and will assess the pupils using the marking grid while they rehearse, as well as marking the final performance at the end of the lesson.

Preparation: The practical performance assessment will take place in one lesson. However, pupils will have lesson time to practice and rehearse their performances with their groups. Pupils need to ensure that lines are learnt before the final performance to achieve the higher grades.

Practical performance skills: Facial expressions, Body language, Gestures, Movement and Levels

Vocal performance skills: Pitch, Pace, Pause, Tone, Emphasis, Intonation and Accent
